Appeal for Assistance from Trail Users:-

An application for funding through the State Government "Open Space" grant scheme by the Goyder Council as lead council together with the Mid Murray Council has unfortunately been unsuccessful under the current round of funding. This grant would have allowed the Lavender Federation Trail to be extended a further 54 kilometers from Truro to Eudunda and the production of an additional map for this section.

We are therefore asking users of the Lavender Federation Trail to consider becoming a "Friend of the Lavender Federation Trail". Your contribution will assist our volunteers to continue to maintain and improve the over 200 kilometers of trail already constructed and plan and survey future sections of trail.
